was born in Washington DC and reared in Lothian, Maryland to Earl and Rose Hall. She received salvation at an early age and began pursuing her God given destiny.

August 12th, 1988, she met the love of her life and married the esteemed Chief Apostle Thomas E. Small, of Portsmouth, Virginia

During 1990, The Small family joined the Greater Church of Deliverance. There she accepted her calling and advanced to the head of the Missionary Department.

She was then promoted to an Evangelist at Greater Church of Deliverance under Bishop Morris Tucker, Presiding. She also served as a Sunday school instructor and Director of The Women's Department.

On July 27th 2008, she was ordained a Prophet by Apostle Lisa Corbitt of Releasing is Glory Ministries.

In September 2008, she birthed a new project, the VDT School of the Prophets. Here, she instructs students how to walk in their callings in the Prophetic ministry.

In her constant quest for knowledge Pastor Francine Small attended Jericho Christian College for four years for Biblical Studies in Washington DC under Apostle Dr. Betty Pebbles. She also attended Theological and Ministry courses at Howard University from 1998-1999. She continued her education under Dr. Michael Freeman, Freedom of Spirit Ministries, National Church of GOD Bible College in Temple Hills, Maryland under Apostle Lowery and Andersonville Bible Seminary in Camilla, Georgia. In 2012 she completed her Doctor in Divinity at Greater Victory Bible Institute in Fort Washington, MD.

On April 1, 2018 God instructed Apostle and Pastor Small to enlarge their territory. They obeyed God, stepped out on faith, and sold the church. The ministry began holding services at Accokeek Academy while the new sanctuary is currently being built.
